

Mr. LAWRENCE BACON (1869-1929)

LAWRENCE Bacon, a resident of Holloway, North London, died a few weeks ago. Mr. Bacon had been a dealer in such rare books as tended to address the occult, philosophy, theology and religion, and you, the reader, may have had dealings with him at his place of business on Liverpool Road despite the tendency for the seller to observe rigorous entry conditions.

Mr. Bacon had been a sometime acquaintance of ours, in fact we used to belong to the same London club, where he was quite inseparable from another, perhaps more intriguing member, Montague Edwards, known to a few of us there as the Laird of Mullardoch. Mr. Bacon's death was a violent one and is as yet unexplained.
