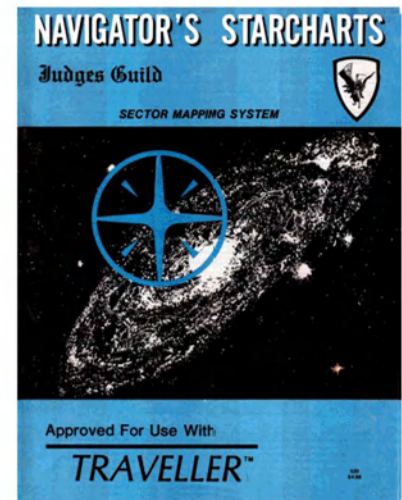

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Judges Guild's 1981 edition of **Navigator's Starcharts** was a sector mapping system for **Traveller** referees. The 112 page 8-1/2 x 11 inch booklet included a Table of Contents (blank so the referee could enter subsector names for six sectors), six blank Sector maps (plus a legend on the back and space for notes), and 96 blank individual subsector maps (and blank planetary contents lists).

This updated PDF edition eliminates the redundant pages and adds rotated pages for ease of reading and printing.

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Navigator's Starcharts had at least two reasonable uses:

- a referee could custom generate and administer a large stellar territory for a comprehensive campaign, and
- a player (taking the role of a navigator) could record the voyages of his ship, noting not only the worlds which he visited, but the uncharted star systems which he observed but had not yet visited.
