1	A ten-inch high stone statue of a bull standing on its hind legs. It's dressed in richly appointed robes, and wearing an ornate crown.	11	A pair of surprisingly comfortable shoes made from the taloned feet of some giant bird of prey. The claws are still dangerously sharp.
2	A lantern made from black iron and dark purple glass. The lantern is shaped like a human baby , its crossed legs forming a loop to hang it by, and its head forming an oil reservoir.	12	A three-foot tall, white-marble statue of a nude human male. It has the head of an elk in place of a human head. The figure holds a wooden knife scribed with jagged lettering.
3	The preserved slit-pupil eyeball of some large creature sealed inside a liquid-filled glass sphere and set into a brass pendant inscribed with five weird symbols.	13	An undead heart mounted in a metal frame, endlessly pumping a sticky black liquid through a series of transparent glass tubes .
4	The stuffed remains of a creature with the head of a raven, the fore-quarters of a lizard, the rear-quarters of a weasel, the tail of a fox, and antelope hooves. There are no seams or breaks in the skin to indicate this is an artificial creation.	14	A forked, greenish-gold fulgurite , about a foot long, stored in an ornate wooden casket marked with a symbol associated with the god of lightning and thunder . Text carved along the sides and back tells the story of a great battle with an otherworldly creature .
5	A pair of gold-plated iron thumbscrews sized for a giant's fingers. Though identical, each bears a different maker's mark . An expert could tell that one is much older than the other.	15	A perfect, bright-orange rose with a blue, twelve-legged beetle-like creature crawling across one petal. Both are preserved in a sphere of unbreakable crystal .
6	A bronze chalice decorated with a pattern that resembles swirling water. Its base is made from a pair of preserved seal flippers.	16	A glass-fronted brass and silver reliquary containing the skeletal remains of stirge , carefully mounted on a piece of gnarled oak.
7	The fossilized remains of a foot-long dragon embedded in a slab of sandstone . There are also tiny humanoid footprints preserved in the stone.	17	A green, cut-glass bottle with a rusty iron stopper. It's filled with a cloudy liquid that has two tiny, nude human figures floating in it.
8	A small, petrified fairy with one wing broken off and crudely reattached with mortar. It clutches a tiny gold casket in its hands.	18	A small leather bag filled with hundreds of teeth , both human and non-human. One demonic fang is capped with black iron and set with a ruby.
9	A pile of six-inch clay globes . Each has something, a bit of bone, a stick, a flap of cloth, or a stone, protruding from its otherwise smooth surface. Should the globes be broken apart, the objects within are completely mundane.	19	A red stone slab that appears to be a sundial. The slab is marked with two overlapping dial faces , and it has two brass gnomons , set at differing heights and angles. Neither dial conforms to any known system of time measurement.
10	A human-sized mask made from a black sheep's head, complete with ears, glass eyes, and teeth. There is a small silk tag , marked with the initials EZT, inside the mask.	20	A spider sculpture made entirely from the wing-bones of various birds, all held together with black metal wire. It rests on a base of phosphorescent green stone .
