1	This well-constructed belt-pouch is made of reddish leather and has a brass closure. It is unremarkable, except for the slim secret compartment sewn into the lining.	11	A dried and hollowed out gourd , painted, sealed with wax, and turned into a canteen. Unfortunately it was once an altar-vessel for an evil demi-human cult . They want it back.
2	This small but sturdy helmet has an odd and unattractive design, but it's in fine shape. The sweat-stained sheepskin liner has a crude map drawn on it's hidden side.	12	A pair of hobnailed leather boots . Perfectly serviceable, except one of the nails has a tendency to jab through the sole when the wearer is running. Ouch!
3	This large silver holy symbol is dedicated to a popular local deity. There is a vial made from blessed glass cleverly concealed within, perfect for storing an emergency supply of holy water.	13	A length of silk rope of the finest quality. Unfortunately it has been treated with a contact poison , the remnant of a murder scheme gone wrong. Handling the rope will produce an adverse reaction.
4	A well-maintained, but worn, brown and dark-red saddle decorated with a leaf and branch pattern. There is a secret pouch sewn into the saddle's skirt. It contains a blood-stained sheet of vellum , on which a brief set of directions starting at the mill stone has been scrawled.	14	A war hammer with a head in the shape of a snarling bear. This very-recognizable weapon once belonged to a well-respected citizen of a nearby town who vanished under suspicious circumstances: foul play by traveling companions. Most people from that town will recognize it, and may question the owner.
5	A bundle of greasy blue candles with a sharp odor. When lit, the smell drives away insects, but might attract larger creatures, especially scent-hunting predators.	15	This set of horseshoes is a bit rusty, but otherwise in good shape. They are made from meteoric iron , and could be smelted down and reforged into something magical.
6	This common lantern is fitted with lenses of dwarf design. These add five feet to its radius of illumination.	16	A worn but well-maintained ice pick . The initials of a famous explorer are engraved on the head. He/she has many tales to tell.
7	This ordinary iron grappling hook has a hidden flaw in its construction. There is a 25% chance it will fail catastrophically when a heavy load is placed upon it.	17	A spell book with a battered, blood-stained leather binding. The pages appear blank, but one contains notes on creating a minor magic item written in invisible ink .
8	A pair of dark-green gloves made from elven cloth. Though they are not magical, the gloves will keep the wearer's hands and fingers warm and nimble, even in the coldest weather.	18	A serviceable but ornate dagger . The quillions are decorated with cheap red gems. Hidden among the junk stones is a single fine ruby , the former owner's emergency cash.
9	A set of iron manacles connected by a foot of heavy chain. They appear completely mundane, but the locks are very insecure . They can be picked with any bit of metal.	19	This small brass snuff box is decorated with a flower and vine pattern set with cut-glass crystals. Pressing the crystals in order opens a tiny secret compartment in the lid.
10	A heavy cloak of dark-gray wool trimmed with glistening silver fur and fastened with a simple iron clasp. The fur was taken from a rare silver wolf . The cloak's former owner knows where to find more of the beasts.	20	These rust-colored leather bracers are decorated with a pair of horned lizards and sized for a thick-wristed man. They once belonged to a famous wrestler , and are worth a fair amount to a fan or collector.
