1	Deep, snow has accumulated here, hiding features and landmarks. Travel is slowed to one-quarter normal. There is a one in six chance of getting lost in the stark terrain .	11	A deep crevasse creates an obvious hazard here. It extends over a mile in either direction. If searched, there is a one in six chance of finding a dead creature at the bottom.
2	Numerous fumaroles spout yellowish clouds of steam and toxic fumes that freeze and fall as snow-like crystals in the chilly air.	12	A ridge of barren stone serves as a windbreak, and thirty-foot-high drifts have created a snow cave that provides limited shelter.
3	Runoff, freezing, and thawing have created a massive ice bridge . It crosses a deep ravine and then leads up the side of a steep hill .	13	This shallow, featureless depression is filled with packed snow. Icy fog is common, and there is a two in six chance of a whiteout .
4	What first appear to be natural stone formations are actually old foundations . Hard to believe anyone would build in this desolate area, but build they did. Little remains of the above-ground portion of this structure, but narrow stairs lead to a cozy stone-walled cellar below.	14	Constant wind had swept this area clear, revealing a featureless stretch of worn rock and sparse soil. During any warm spell , low-growing, flowering plants spring forth, covering the ground. There is a one in six chance an herbalist can find valuable or useful plants under these conditions.
5	A layer of icy snow covers a deep crevasse , hiding it from view. The snow-bridge is strong enough to support individuals, but will collapse if several people try to cross at once.	15	Ridges and dips are hidden beneath yards-deep snow , making travel tedious. The drifts are soft and deep enough to completely bury a person . Halve movement rates.
6	A few scraggly, wind-twisted evergreens huddle against the leeward side of a massive boulder . Their branches provide scant shelter , but at least there's a bit of firewood available.	16	Shifting ice has exposed the deep-frozen corpses of a dozen huge beasts. The stench is terrible, and there is a three in six chance the thawing flesh will draw scavengers to the site.
7	A brief thaw has unleashed swarms of biting flies and huge mosquitoes . Anyone spending the night in this area gets no sleep .	17	Linear mounds of gravel, rocks, and boulders make up a broad moraine that marks the ancient path of a glacier .
8	The land ahead presents a dichotomy: green-tinted, swampy lowlands studded with sheer-sided, snow-covered plateaus of weathered rock. Travel is slowed by soggy ground and cliff-like obstacles.	18	Rotten canvas hanging from twisted wooden frames marks the last campsite of a doomed expedition. Rail-thin, frozen corpses and gnawed bones paint a grisly picture of the party's cannibalistic end .
9	A number of steamy springs bubble out of the ground here, creating a dozen warm to hot pools . There is a one in six chance that bathing in these pools will have a minor beneficial effect on the bather's health.	19	A half-frozen river crosses the area ahead, creating a treacherous obstacle. There are places where a solid sheet of ice stretches between the banks, but there's a two in six chance these crossings are unstable .
10	This rocky hillside is dotted with tiny springs that trickle down the slope and freeze into twisted and rippled sheets of ice . There is a five in six chance anyone crossing this area will fall, sliding to the base of the slope.	20	An ancient fault-line has slipped, creating a wall-like cliff . Several caves in the rock face have been worked and expanded by hopeful miners. There is a one in six chance of finding useful supplies or tools in these caves.
