1	Pennytrap is a rare copper-colored liquid. Once injected it takes days to manifest, but once it does the victim suffers horribly: blinded, paralyzed, and covered with bleeding sores.	11	Twitch's delicate amber crystals produce a yellowish vapor when crushed. Inhaling the vapors produces muscle spasms and delirium. Fleeing thieves Twitch to disable pursuit.
2	Milky green Itchwound is commonly used on edged weapons, drying clear and hard. Wounds inflicted with a treated blade burn and itch, while the victim's vision blurs and doubles.	12	Sliver crystals are golden and needle-like, sharp enough to pierce flesh. They dissolve and spread through the bloodstream, producing disorienting dizziness and mental agitation.
3	Yellow and oily Mindfog emits colorless, odorless fumes when exposed to air. A few minutes exposure causes drowsiness and confusion for several hours. Once they recover, victims have no memory of the past day.	13	Murderer's Mud looks like moist earth. The contact poison is distilled from the leaves and flowers of rare tropical vines. One touch causes nausea, vomiting, and blindness, debilitating symptoms that last for days.
4	Starflower Oil is commonly used as a perfume, but the pink liquid is poisonous if ingested. It affects the nervous system, causing twitching, tremors, and severe pain within seconds.	14	Brewer's Blood is a pale yellow powder. It can be consumed without harm so long as no alcohol is drunk. Mixed with drink it causes fever, nausea, and vomiting.
5	Spider Dust is a fine greenish-gray powder that is absorbed through the skin. Symptoms manifest as crawling sensations on the skin, and delirium. Victims often draw their own blood as they try to rid themselves of the phantasmal bugs.	15	Assassins and thieves often rub their weapons with pieces of Eyebite , a natural stone found in silver mines. Those struck are rendered blind and mute as their eyes water uncontrollably and their tongues and lips swell to tremendous size. Some victims choke to death.
6	Purple jelly-like Gorecrow shows no symptoms when ingested, but it thins the blood and prevents clotting. Victims can bleed to death from minor wounds. Its effects last weeks.	16	Blue Sleep is a crystalline substance created from rare minerals. It is a simple contact poison that swiftly shuts down the nervous and circulatory systems of anyone that touches it.
7	Glutton Salt looks like common table salt. When ingested it causes ravenous hunger, then sudden agonizing pain and convulsions.	17	Shriek Sting is distilled from the venom of common spiders. Victims suffer hours of wracking pain and scream uncontrollably, a symptom which gives the toxin its name.
8	Lung Rot is a brown powder made from cold-climate mosses and lichens. Once ingested it accumulates in the lungs. Severe coughing leads to lung collapse as tissues are destroyed by this deadly substance.	18	Troll's Taint is a dark red toxin made from troll's blood and rare subterranean fungi. Wild tumorous growths sprout from the flesh of those touched by this poison, leaving the victim twisted and crippled.
9	Demon's Touch is a black tar-like magical venom. Once the tasteless substance is ingested the victim's skin becomes toxic; anyone they touch suffers fever, convulsions, and sometimes death. This effect is permanent.	19	Death is the usual fate of anyone cut with a Fire Worm coated blade. The clear liquid reacts with blood, creating crawling red lines all over the victim's body. Potent headaches, nausea, paralysis, and death soon follow.
10	The sweet taste of Dull Balm hides its insidious nature. The slow poison accumulates in the digestive system, painlessly destroying the body's ability to absorb nutrients.	20	Odorless, tasteless, colorless, Assassin's Pet is the professional's deadly poison of choice. Many amateur poisoners have killed themselves trying to use this tricky liquid.
