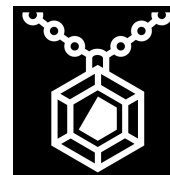

1	The water-shedding ring has a silver band set with an aquamarine. It creates a magical field that repels moisture, protecting the wearer and their garb from rain and splashing water.	11	The stonecloth cloak is woven from tough, mottled gray fibers. It grants the wearer with a defensive bonus and serves as high-quality camouflage in rocky terrain or natural caves.
2	These boot buckles are made of cheap tin wrapped with old, brown leather. When worn they grants a small movement bonus and reduce fatigue caused by walking or running.	12	The pot of spring is made of plain clay and scribed with a pattern of leaves and flowers. A seed planted in its magical soil sprouts and grows to maturity within a day.
3	Using this silver-trimmed monocle for more than a few minutes gives the owner a pounding headache. It also reveals magical inscriptions and writings, although it does not provide any understanding of their meaning.	13	This bamboo pan flute is decorated with magical runes. A magic user proficient with the instrument can use it to store up to five spells. Playing a brief tune on the pan flute consumes and casts one of the stored spells.
4	There are several secret compartments sewn into the green leather of the sentinel belt. The belt's enchantment warns the wearer when someone attempts to pick their pocket.	14	The envoy's pendant, a gold disk inscribed with an ornate seal, was created for city messengers. Mundane domestic animals like dogs and cats ignore anyone wearing this item.
5	This white, fur-covered bag has a ribbon-like drawstring. Perishable items stored in the sack remain fresh so long as it remains sealed.	15	The jade and onyx gambler's dice grant their owner luck unless there's cash involved. In that case, they have the opposite effect.
6	The time stagger amulet resembles a coppery metal band formed into a Möbius strip. Once per day, the wearer can invoke its power to redo a single action, essentially rewinding time.	16	The resounding ring is a thick steel band inscribed with a pattern of open mouths. Upon command the ring amplifies the wearer's voice significantly. Extended use can cause deafness.
7	The brass transformation kettle is decorated with an appealing pattern and has a polished ash handle. Plain water heated in the kettle can be transformed into tea, coffee, or another mundane hot beverage by speaking a command word.	17	What appears to be a glass vial of mundane ink is actually a living tattoo. When the vessel is opened the ink spews out, instantly creating a tattoo on the opener that looks like a random nearby creature. The mark grants a minor magical power related to its appearance.
8	Candles of benevolence burn with a dim blue flame. Intelligent creatures exposed to this light experience intense feelings of empathy for any living thing they encounter for the next hour.	18	Placing the dull gray delectable pebble beneath one's tongue staves off the effects of hunger and thirst for up to three days. Soaking the stone in fine wine restores its potency.
9	The copyist's page is a square of mimic hide soaked in the blood of a doppelganger. Lay it on a map, inscription, or page of text and speak the command word to capture an exact copy of the source material.	19	The grasping gloves are made of slick hide that changes color to match the owner's other garb. Invoking their power transforms the wearer's fingers into three-foot-long tentacles covered in tiny gripping suckers.
10	The iron knocker appears to be nothing more than a rusty pull ring for a door. Holding the knocker against a locked or magically sealed portal and speaking the command word opens the door.	20	The traveler's seal is a cloak clasp carved from petrified wood. It grants its wearer a minor bonus when carrying out survival tasks like starting a fire, foraging for food, or searching for clean water.
