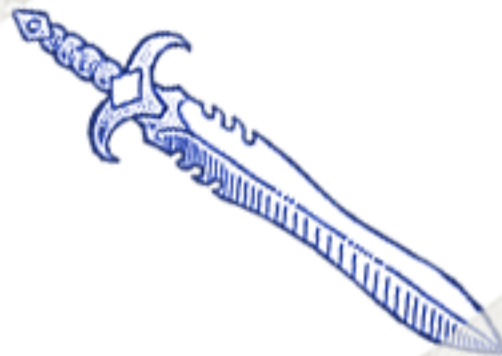

1001 Strange Swords

Garin's hobnails clicked on the cobblestones as the party walked slowly but purposefully down the narrow street. The ancient, decrepit buildings divided by the street seemed to want to come together again, reaching upper stories together overhead. Many of the buildings contained small shops, and the party checked each sign. Finally they halted at one consisting of two gold-painted balls, and a dangling chain where a third once hung. After a brief pause, they entered.

GM: This definitely looks like the right place. You can't even see the walls, the place is so crowded with clutter. It seems that everything someone might want to pawn, from a lute missing a string to a pair of boots big enough for an ogre, is around here somewhere. Mostly, in your way.

Party Leader: Do we see the pawnbroker anywhere?

Jarmak: Do we see any magic swords?

GM: There's someone in the dimly-lit back of the shop; that's probably the pawnbroker. As for swords, one of the few lanterns in here is illuminating a rack of swords, axes, and miscellaneous other weapons.

Party Leader: We'll take a closer look. We know Yannerby pawned that sword here before he died, so it pretty much has has to be one of those.

Jarmak: Kalthras, why don't you just do your magic finding spell?

Kalthras: You heard the constable at the gate: Spellcasting is prohibited in town, except for the Mage Guild. Which, by the way, I am hoping will not notice that I am here at all.

Party Leader: This shouldn't be that hard. A magic sword will look distinctive. Interesting. Not like the rest. **turns to GM** How many swords are there, and what do they look like?

GM: Well, you know the magic sword you're hunting was a longsword, so there are three that could be it. One has a gold hilt with a fluted rosewood grip, and the pommel is the head of an eagle with what look to be diamond eyes. The guard is its wings, and its body merges into the steel of the blade. The second has a plain steel hilt, with a grip wrapped in some bumpy gray hide and wound with copper wire. The pommel is a crystal cabochon. The guard is a partial basket and the blade is made of what looks like black crystal. The third has an odd-colored metal hilt that you think is what they call star-metal, with a fluted purplish crystal grip. The pommel is a lion's paw clutching a crystal sphere. The guard is two sharp flanges, and the blade is made of Damascus steel etched with words in an alphabet you don't recognize.

Jarmak: I wonder if any of them has "Property of Yannerby" scratched in it somewhere?

Swords in a fantasy world are the work of skilled craftsmen, not stamped out by machines. The journeyman-made ones sold to beginning adventurers or bought by the barrel-full by those looking to equip armies are plain enough, but any truly interesting swords are as unique as those who commissioned them and made them.

The bandit leader might only have a +1 sword, or even one not magical at all, but if it has a dragon's body for the hilt, with the blade emerging from its mouth, that's a lot more interesting. What's that written on the blade the orcs had? A clue to the current mystery? Are those real gems decorating that other one, and if so, could they be more valuable than all the rest of the horde?

1001 Strange Swords gives you a plethora of interesting swords to intrigue your players. You can use them exactly as written, or pick one you like and tweak the details to suit your needs. They can be daggers, two-handers, or anything else in the same general style. Put them in treasures, in the hands of villains and heroes, or even in pawnshops, and add more color and detail to your game.

- 1: The hilt of this sword is made of silver. The pommel is a landshark's head with emerald eyes. The guard is two sharp flanges. The grip is carved rosewood. The curved blade is made of unadorned bronze.
- 2: The hilt of this sword is made of silver. The pommel is the head of a gargoyle with diamond eyes. The guard is its wings. Its body merges into the blade. The grip is spiral-turned maple wood. The long, wide blade is made of pinkish crystal etched with the sword's name in dwarven runes.
- 3: The hilt of this sword is made of mithril. The pommel is a skeletal hand. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is spiral-turned ebony. The wavy blade is made of silver etched with its first bearer's name in ornate writing.
- 4: The hilt of this sword is made of silver. The pommel is a hydra's head. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is spiral-turned yellowish crystal. The leaf-shaped blade is made of steel etched with abstract patterns.
- 5: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a roc's head. The guard is a simple crosspiece. The grip is fluted maple wood. The narrow blade is made of clear glass etched with abstract patterns.
- 6: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is an amethyst cabochon. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is brass-wound maple wood. The extremely curved blade is made of steel etched with scenes of battle.
- 7: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is a goat's head. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is cross-hatched unmelting ice. The single-edged, curved blade is made of yellowish crystal etched with scenes of battle.
- 8: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is an eagle's head with diamond eyes. The guard is a simple crosspiece. The grip is smooth maple wood. The long, narrow blade is made of unadorned bronze.
- 9: The hilt of this sword is made of gold. The pommel is the head of an eagle with diamond eyes. The guard is its wings. Its body merges into the blade. The grip is fluted rosewood. The leaf-shaped blade is made of steel.
- 10: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is the head of a griffon. The guard is its wings. Its body merges into the blade. The grip is wrapped in green leather and wound with silver wire. The long blade is made of steel etched with its first bearer's name in elven script.
- 11: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is a dragon's claw clutching an amber sphere. The guard is 5 curved rods. The grip is carved pinkish crystal. The short, wide blade is made of steel etched with a harpies.
- 12: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a crystal cabochon. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is wrapped in gargoyle hide and wound with copper wire. The long blade is made of unadorned black crystal.
- 13: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is a falcon's head. The guard is 4 curved rods. The grip is wrapped in grey calfskin and wound with copper wire. The wavy blade is made of unadorned steel.
- 14: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a dragon's claw clutching a smoky quartz sphere. The guard is a fluted crosspiece with an eagle's head at each end. The grip is smooth ebony. The narrow blade is made of unadorned steel.
- 15: The hilt of this sword is made of silver. The pommel is a crystal cabochon. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is cross-hatched ironwood. The long blade is made of steel etched with a curse in elaborate calligraphy.

16: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is a roc's head. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is wrapped in gargoyle hide and wound with steel wire. The short, wide blade is made of bronze etched with a motto in ancient runes.

17: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a griffon's head. The guard is two sharp flanges. The grip is wrapped in silver dragonskin and wound with steel wire. The long blade is made of unadorned bronze.

18: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a hydra's head. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is wrapped in violet dragonskin and wound with steel wire. The wide, single-edged blade is made of star-metal etched with scenes of battle.

19: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is an amphisbaena's head with emerald eyes. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is cross-hatched smoky crystal. The narrow blade is made of unadorned steel.

20: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is the head of an eagle. The guard is its wings. Its body merges into the blade. The grip is fluted obsidian. The short, narrow blade is made of unadorned black crystal.

21: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is a wolf's paw clutching a crystal sphere. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is fluted cherry wood. The wavy blade is made of steel.

22: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is a wolf's paw clutching a smoky quartz sphere. The guard is two sharp flanges. The grip is wrapped in manticores hide and wound with platinum wire. The leaf-shaped blade is made of plain iron.

23: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a bull's head. The guard is 4 curved rods. The grip is smooth exotic wood. The long, wide blade is made of steel etched with a floral design.

24: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is an agate cabochon. The guard is a simple crosspiece. The grip is wrapped in silver leather and wound with brass wire. The short blade is made of unadorned steel.

25: The hilt of this sword is made of star-metal. The pommel is a turquoise cabochon. The guard is two sharp flanges. The grip is spiral-turned ivory. The leaf-shaped blade is made of bronze etched with a curse in elaborate calligraphy.

26: The hilt of this sword is made of copper. The pommel is the tail of an eagle, the guard is its wings, and its head holds the blade in its mouth. The grip is smooth ironwood. The long blade is made of plain grey glass.

27: The hilt of this sword is made of silver. The pommel is a dragon's claw clutching a crystal sphere. The guard is a simple crosspiece. The grip is ribbed purplish crystal. The leaf-shaped blade is made of plain steel.

28: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is a topaz cabochon. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is wrapped in brown horsehide and wound with copper wire. The long blade is made of steel etched with a battle-cry in elven script.

29: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a fire Drake's head. The guard is 6 curved rods. The grip is wrapped in wyvern hide and wound with silver wire. The short, wide blade is made of steel etched with its first bearer's name in dwarven runes.

30: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is an amber cabochon. The guard is a fluted crosspiece with a dragon's head at each end. The grip is spiral-turned bone. The narrow blade is made of bronze etched with its first bearer's name in elven script.

31: The hilt of this sword is made of mithril. The pommel is a goat's head with garnet eyes. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is ribbed bone. The short, wide blade is made of unadorned steel.

32: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is an eagle's head with topaz eyes. The guard is 4 curved rods. The grip is carved ironwood. The short, narrow blade is made of steel etched with scenes of battle.

33: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a dragon's claw clutching an opal sphere. The guard is a simple crosspiece. The grip is smooth ironwood. The curved blade is made of unadorned bronze.

34: The hilt of this sword is made of mithril. The pommel is a griffon's head. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is wrapped in hydra hide and wound with brass wire. The leaf-shaped blade is made of steel.

35: The hilt of this sword is made of copper. The pommel is a turquoise cabochon. The guard is a simple crosspiece. The grip is wrapped in catoblepas hide and wound with platinum wire. The short, narrow, single-edged blade is made of steel etched with scenes of battle.

36: The hilt of this sword is made of mithril. The pommel is an amethyst cabochon. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is wrapped in basilisk hide and wound with copper wire. The single-edged, curved blade is made of steel etched with a religious exhortation in elaborate calligraphy.

37: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a falcon's head. The guard is 6 curved rods. The grip is carved horn. The short, single-edged, extremely curved blade is made of steel etched with a stags fighting a falcons.

38: The hilt of this sword is made of mithril. The pommel is an eagle's head. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is spiral-turned ebony. The extremely curved blade is made of unadorned iron.

39: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is a clenched fist clutching a crystal sphere. The guard is two sharp flanges. The grip is fluted unmelting ice. The narrow blade is made of iron etched with a floral design.

40: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a goat's head with garnet eyes. The guard is 4 curved rods. The grip is spiral-turned rosewood. The short, narrow blade is made of plain steel.

41: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is the head of a gargoyle. The guard is its wings. Its body merges into the blade. The grip is wrapped in white dragonskin and wound with copper wire. The leaf-shaped blade is made of steel etched with abstract patterns.

42: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is an eagle's head. The guard is a simple crosspiece. The grip is wrapped in violet dragonskin and wound with silver wire. The short, narrow blade is made of silver etched with a curse in dwarven runes.

43: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is a skeletal hand clutching an amber sphere. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is steel-wound cherry wood. The single-edged, curved blade is made of steel etched with a religious exhortation in ornate writing.

44: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a catoblepas's head with emerald eyes. The guard is two sharp flanges. The grip is wrapped in silver leather and wound with copper wire. The leaf-shaped blade is made of unadorned Damascus steel.

45: The hilt of this sword is made of mithril. The pommel is a smoky quartz cabochon. The guard is a simple crosspiece. The grip is smooth oak wood. The short, wide blade is made of unadorned adamantium.

46: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a landshark's head. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is smooth maple wood. The wide blade is made of silver.

47: The hilt of this sword is made of star-metal. The pommel is a lion's paw clutching a crystal sphere. The guard is two sharp flanges. The grip is fluted purplish crystal. The long blade is made of Damascus steel etched with a religious exhortation in an archaic alphabet.

48: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is the tail of a falcon, the guard is its wings, and its head holds the blade in its mouth. The grip is carved ebony. The leaf-shaped blade is made of steel etched with a motto in ancient runes.

49: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is the tail of a gargoyle, the guard is its wings, and its head, with garnet eyes, holds the blade in its mouth. The grip is ribbed exotic wood. The curved blade is made of plain bronze.

51: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is the head of a winged serpent. The guard is its wings. Its body merges into the blade. The grip is fluted smoky crystal. The wide blade is made of bronze etched with a motto in elaborate calligraphy.

57: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a demon's head. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is cross-hatched exotic wood. The short blade is made of bronze etched with a floral design.

58: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a sea-monster's head. The guard is 4 curved rods. The grip is carved ivory. The long, wide blade is made of unadorned steel.

66: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is a bloodstone cabochon. The guard is 5 curved rods. The grip is wrapped in silver dragonskin and wound with steel wire. The short, single-edged, curved blade is made of unadorned yellowish crystal.

67: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is the tail of an eagle, the guard is its wings, and its head holds the blade in its mouth. The grip is wrapped in gold dragonskin and wound with brass wire. The long, curved blade is made of plain steel.

68: The hilt of this sword is made of mithril. The pommel is a wyvern's head. The guard is two sharp flanges. The grip is gold-wound maple wood. The wavy blade is made of unadorned steel.

69: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is the tail of a harpy, the guard is its wings, and its head holds the blade in its mouth. The grip is ribbed ironwood. The wide blade is made of steel etched with a heraldic coat of arms.

70: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is the tail of a roc, the guard is its wings, and its head holds the blade in its mouth. The grip is spiral-turned oak wood. The wide blade is made of steel etched with abstract patterns.

73: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a phoenix's head with sapphire eyes. The guard is 3 curved rods. The grip is fluted rosewood. The wavy blade is made of yellowish crystal etched with a knightly motto in dwarven runes.

74: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is the head of a falcon with topaz eyes. The guard is its wings. Its body merges into the blade. The grip is carved smoky crystal. The single-edged, curved blade is made of plain bronze.

75: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a crystal cabochon. The guard is a fluted crosspiece with a roc's head at each end. The grip is wrapped in black dragonskin and wound with steel wire. The long blade is made of steel etched with scenes of battle.

76: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is an amber cabochon. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is wrapped in violet dragonskin and wound with steel wire. The extremely curved blade is made of steel etched with abstract patterns.

77: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is an opal cabochon. The guard is two sharp flanges. The grip is wrapped in brown dragonskin and wound with gold wire. The single-edged, curved blade is made of bronze etched with a heraldic coat of arms.

78: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a lizard's head. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is smooth ironwood. The long, narrow blade is made of steel etched with a heraldic coat of arms.

79: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is an eagle's head. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is spiral-turned maple wood. The short blade is made of bronze etched with abstract patterns.

80: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is a basilisk's head. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is wrapped in white calfskin and wound with mithril wire. The leaf-shaped blade is made of steel etched with a floral design.

81: The hilt of this sword is made of gold. The pommel is an agate cabochon. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is wrapped in dinosaur hide and wound with silver wire. The leaf-shaped blade is made of unadorned steel.

82: The hilt of this sword is made of star-metal. The pommel is a gargoyle's head with emerald eyes. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is silver-wound smoky crystal. The curved blade is made of unadorned steel.

83: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a chimera's head. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is fluted cherry wood. The wide blade is made of steel etched with a falcon fighting a horse.

84: The hilt of this sword is made of star-metal. The pommel is the tail of a demon, the guard is its wings, and its head holds the blade in its mouth. The grip is smooth pinkish crystal. The wavy blade is made of bronze.

85: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is a crystal cabochon. The guard is 2 curved rods. The grip is wrapped in silver leather and wound with steel wire. The wide blade is made of Damascus steel.

86: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is an amethyst cabochon. The guard is a simple crosspiece. The grip is wrapped in grey leather and wound with gold wire. The short, wide blade is made of plain iron.

87: The hilt of this sword is made of bronze. The pommel is a clenched fist. The guard is a knobbed crosspiece. The grip is carved ivory. The long, single-edged, curved blade is made of Damascus steel etched with its first bearer's name in elaborate calligraphy.

88: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a dragon's head with emerald eyes. The guard is a simple crosspiece. The grip is wrapped in gargoyle hide and wound with mithril wire. The wavy blade is made of clear crystal.

89: The hilt of this sword is made of brass. The pommel is a moonstone cabochon. The guard is a partial basket. The grip is fluted greenish crystal. The narrow blade is made of plain Damascus steel.

99: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is an agate cabochon. The guard is 4 curved rods. The grip is wrapped in black leather and wound with brass wire. The extremely curved blade is made of steel etched with a battle-cry in ornate writing.

100: The hilt of this sword is made of silver. The pommel is a moonstone cabochon. The guard is a fluted crosspiece with a mantichore's head at each end. The grip is steel-wound obsidian. The long, single-edged, curved blade is made of greenish crystal etched with abstract patterns.

101: The hilt of this sword is made of steel. The pommel is a skeletal hand clutching an opal sphere. The guard is a fluted crosspiece with a horse's head at each end. The grip is wrapped in silver dragonskin and wound with steel wire. The narrow blade is made of silver.

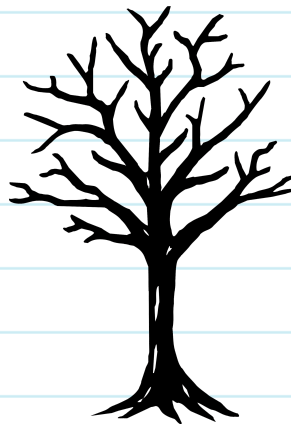
