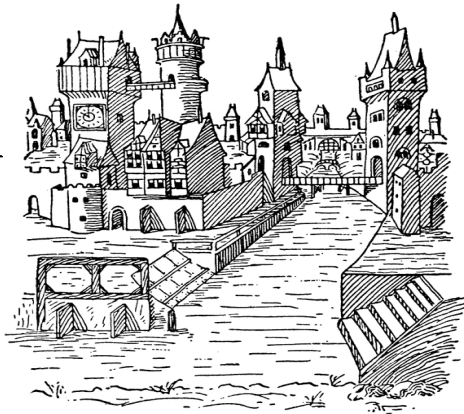


The suffix "Caster" on a place name, has the meaning that it was once a Roman military fort. While the suffix "Thwaite" means a forest clearing with a dwelling and land!

Place names ending in "Thorpe" mean secondary settlement to a larger one nearby, while the prefix "Swin" refers to Pigs (as in swine)

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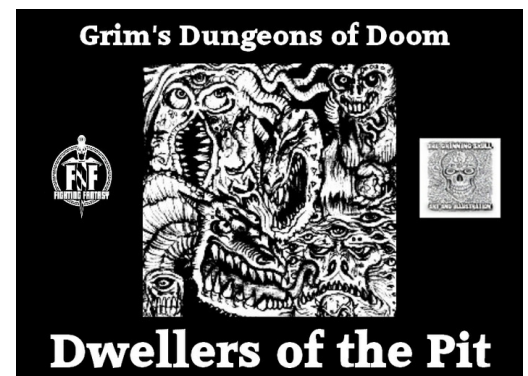
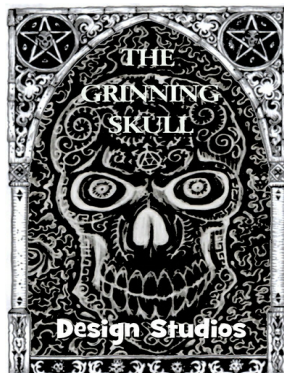
