VINCENT LITTLE CREEK

The following star NPC is provided to allow GMs to use him in any number of scenarios being run in the Central/Upper Plains of the USA. The character's background story makes one assumption as to a specific target of the PRC nuclear attack. It should be noted that the GM is under no obligation to adhere to this assumption and, in all likelihood, will have no bearing on most games.

SYNOPSIS

Vincent Little Creek is a Native American outdoorsman who shares a truly close bond with the land and his people. As a child growing up in and around the Badlands of South Dakota, he was unremarkable in that he was profoundly “normal” and “average” when it came to the usual childhood activities such as school, sports and family life. Where he stood out was his love and interest in the outdoors. A blooming gift and thirst to commune with nature led to his selection by the tribal elders to learn the ways of his ancestors. Because of this, his loyalties and affections are to his people first. After a short stint through technical school, he returned to the life of the outdoors as a field guide, instructor, explorer and survivor in the Last Year.

HISTORY

Vincent Little Creek was born in 1983 in Pine Ridge, South Dakota. A member of the Oglala Lakota, a tribe within the Sioux Nation, Vincent has spent his entire life growing up in a house in Manderson, South Dakota on the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation.

Throughout his formative years, Vincent found that he had a great affinity for the outdoors, every aspect of it. When he wasn't in school or helping his family with chores, he spent his time in the hills, forests and stream beds on the reservation. As he got older his trips out of the house became longer, the distances greater. By the time he was an early teen-ager, he was recognized throughout the tribe and the reservation as one of the best experts on the area.

His love and thirst to know more of the land, to become part of the land, awakened something deep within him and he longed to know, understand and relate to his ancestors. He approached the tribal elders in an effort to gain more insight, but he got more than he ever suspected he would get. Despite the tribe's practice of passing knowledge on to the next generations, Vincent had already been selected for special grooming because of his natural, innate abilities. As he learned, he continued to want more and more.

At the age of 15, in the heart of his learning and growth, he was hired as part of a team of local experts to guide scientists and paleontologists who would scour the Badlands as part of their research or the hunt for the next big dinosaur find. Just before he turned 18, he was on-hand during a field accident with one of the teams where three people died and nine others were seriously injured. Thanks to his initiative and training, he proved critical in providing aid and assisting in the rescue of the party, however the event had a deep, resonating effect on Vincent.

Shortly after the rescue, Vincent withdrew from his family and spent even more time out in the wild alone with his thoughts. He couldn't shake the thought that somehow, the accident was his fault. He reasoned that if he was so in touch with the land and his ancestors, how could he have let this happen? Deciding that those men were punished for his short-comings, Vincent decided to pursue a more modern calling.

Attending a small, vocational trade school in the area, Vincent spent a couple of years learning the ins and outs of small, internal combustion engines and general vehicle maintenance. Upon graduation, he worked at a local shop on the reservation that rented and repaired dirt bikes.

It was during this time tuning and fixing motorcycles that Vincent once again heard the strong call of the wilderness and an unexplainable tug from within to begin his pursuits of his ancestral heritage, knowledge and customs. He began working again as a field guide for campers, day-trippers and various expeditions. As the world situation gradually became worse, he found the types of people coming through to be more and more rugged or more and more open to what he had to say and the tips he shared.

Though he was over 50 miles from Ellsworth AFB, home of the 28th Bomb Wing and its B-1B bombers near Rapid City, the Chinese missiles that targeted that facility were too close for his liking. Vincent decided it was time to leave any areas with populations of any significance and to head out into the country, returning to local towns only for supplies as he needed them.

When in conflict or doubt his loyalties are, in order: the Oglala Lakota, the other branches of the Lakota tribe, the Sioux Nation, any other American Indian population, the USA, then the rest of the human race.
