

## Omikkee Sharif

O-mi-khee Sharif is the proud owner and proprietor of 'the Twisted Goat' Inn. Formerly the intended servant of an Mordheim Moneylender, he took turn for the better when Mordheim was hit. He appropriated a lot of the cash-stack from the suddenly accessible strongroom and went into hiding for some time. Then he resurfaced and used the money to be a derelict Inn. That same Inn is now the prosperous 'Twisted Goat', one of the best places to pick up rumours, make deals and rest your tired bones.

Omikhee can not be hired as such. He however provides very valuable services for Warbands and Hired Swords alike.

- Banker.

Omikhee picked up a lot of knowledge whilst working for his former master and will put that knowledge to use for you. IT is not totaly without risk, as sometimes shipments he invests in go lost, crops dont come in etc. However he will try and get the highest profit for the money you entrust him with.

In the Postgame sequence you roll for the yield on you investment roll 2d6-1d6 to determine the percentage of your profit or loss when the result is a negative !! After this you can either withdraw OR deposit more.

- Liason.

Most, if not all, of the Alter Ego's, can be contact by leaving a message at the 'Twisted Goat'. Leaving a message is free. However, if you use this service, Omikhee might ask you a favour in the future, like guarding a warehouse, making a delivery run.....

- Broker.

If you use Omikhee as your banker he will also be your middleman and broker deals for you. Any uncommon or rare purchases can be made at 2 steps LOWER then they would normaly be....!! Any material you want to sell, he will manage to dispers of at 75 percent of value instead of 50.

- Revalidation Insurance

For a PRE-game FEE of 2 GP per Hero and 1 GP per Henchman in your Band, you get to Reroll your injury results, letting the better result stand. This fee is non-reimbursable. This represents the facilities in the Inn that you can use, recuperating after a battle, and having a chirurgain and some medicine available.
